
COVID HEALTH FORM LINK



Everyone entering and exiting the studio must follow proper signage/arrows to ensure proper traffic control into the facility. Everyone will be required to use hand sanitizer that will be provided.




Students are to arrive no earlier than 5 minutes prior to the start of their class. This is to reduce the number of students in the building at one time.



Change rooms will be open strictly for changing before, after, or in between classes. Dancers are to bring bags into the dance room and leave them in their "my stuff space".



Waiting room will be open to parent/guardians of dancers in the Dynamic Babies and Tiny Tot dance programs only (dancers aged 2-4). One parent/guardian per dancer and masks must be worn. Vaccine passport in effect.



We are limiting the our class sizes to a maximum of 10 participants to ensure proper physical distancing and dance spaces will be clearly marked by blue boxes. Everyone must remain 2m (6 ft) distance in waiting areas at all times.



Disinfecting and cleaning will happen between each class and more frequently for high touch contact surfaces (washrooms, front desk, door handles, etc.). All ballet barres, acro mats, and other teaching aids will be sanitized after use. Spray sanitizer & disposable towels will be made available to clean throughout the studio.



Masks are mandatory for ALL participants and anyone entering the facility. Masks to be worn while dancing to reduce risk of transmission.



BEFORE YOU COME TO CLASS



All parents/guardians must complete a DDA Covid-19 screener/tracking form each day their dancer(s) come into the studio.

If a dancer or anyone in their household is unwell, the dancer is not permitted to attend class. This will also be in effect for those who have, or anyone in their household have, travelled outside of Ontario within 14 days prior to their class and are not vaccinated.



AS YOU ARRIVE FOR CLASS



Make sure that you have your mask on before entering the facility!

As you enter the studio, you will be required to sign in with a staff member to ensure proper tracking in/out of the studio. Please come dressed for class if possible to limit the amount of students in the change rooms.

Dancer's will be let in and are asked to follow signage and stand on the designated spots outside the classrooms. Teachers will let them in once the room has been sanitized. Dancers will be required to sanitize their hands at the classroom door before entering.



DURING CLASS



Teachers will be wearing masks. All barres, mats, etc. will be sanitized between each class. Dancers will be dancing inside their designated boxes to ensure proper social distancing. Dancers are required to also wear masks as sometimes maintaining social distance is not possible. Students are encouraged to bring their own yoga mats to place inside their boxes or on top of acro mats.



AFTER CLASS IS DONE



Once a class is finished, teachers will let the students out and parents are to be waiting inside (ages 2-4) or outside our main doors. A staff member will be at the doors to ensure the safety of students.

POLICIES

- Due to the uncertainties as a result of COVID-19, we are only offering instalment or nine (9) monthly payments for the 2021/2022 dance season
- All payment policies regarding late fees, withdrawals, refunds/credits, and costumes all remain the same as our general policies.
- If Dynamic Dance Arts is required to suspend in-studio classes due to an Emergency Declaration or other required closure(s), all dance classes will continue via Zoom. Class times and days will remain the same and all tuition will be reduced to 70% of your monthly/instalment amount and continue throughout the duration of online classes.

Due to government mandate, DDA is now required to follow the

Vaccine Passport:

Those parents of dancers ages 4 and under that are waiting inside throughout the duration of their dancer's class must show proof of double vaccination. If you are unable to provide proof, you are welcomed to come inside to pay, use the washroom, or get your child settled and/or picked up for class.
